Summer camp: June 29 - July 2 (1/2 week x \$600/1/2 week) = \$600.00, plus room & meals.

Job Summary: Creates and facilitates summer camp programming for POD camp, an intergenerational camp. Collaborates with the Director team to create a POD camp activities and schedule; and leads the program during the ½ week at camp.

Skills and Qualifications Ability to: Facilitate programming for campers of all ages, from toddlers to adults, that is focused on anti-racism, pro-LGBTQIA+, and consistent with the mission of Pilgrim Pines Camp; support volunteers; showcase knowledge and expertise in programming for intergenerational campers; maintain focus on mission and organization program components; and promote social justice and anti-racist/bias mindset. Must be 22 years old or older.
