Job Summary: Will supervise the Pines' Health Center during camper-counselor camps, including administration of all medications for campers, addressing minor illness and injuries, encouraging health and wellness for campers and staff, and supporting emergency care if needed.

Skills and QualificationsMust have a current RN or LVN license, along with current CPR/First Aid/AED. Health care will be administered to promote health and wellness for all, consistent with the mission and vision of the Camp, and with a priority for attention to social justice and anti-racist/bias mindset. This includes a medical practice that is focused on eliminating any ableist, fat phobic, transphobic, and/or anti-Black health care practices.

Key Responsibilities

- Maintaining and supervising the Health Center in compliance with CA State and SB County regulations for health care at organized camps.
- Welcoming all campers with hospitality and care, a health check, check-in of medications, and confirmation with parent/guardian of any health issues.
- Oversee inventory and ordering of health center supplies and organization of medication room, oversee updates to standing orders and health center policies/procedures.
- Keeping detailed log of all medications and care provided to campers and staff during the camp session, contact parents/guardians with any concerns or questions during the sessions.
- Provide first aid care for minor illness or injuries, and support emergency or urgent care if needed, following the standing orders and policies, and communicating with parents/guardians.
- Providing reminders and support to staff and campers about overall health and wellness, especially prevention of illness and injury at camp.
- Complete other duties as assigned.
